Health Department partners with Mall of Georgia to offer FREE H1N1 Vaccinations to General Public

(GWINNETT, GA) The East Metro Health District is partnering with the Mall of Georgia® Simon Malls, to offer FREE H1N1 vaccinations (nasal & injectable) this weekend at the Mall of Georgia located at 3333 Buford Drive Buford, Georgia 30519.

The H1N1 clinic will be set up on the 2nd floor of the mall between William-Sonoma & Purfumania. H1N1 clinic hours will be from 9:00am to 10:00pm on Saturday & from 10:00am to 8:00pm on Sunday.

The State of Georgia relaxed restrictions to the vaccine, allowing health district to now make it available to the general population.

“We understand that people are busy trying to get their last minute holiday shopping done and find it difficult to come to our clinics,” states Dr. Lloyd Hofer, Public Health Director for the East Metro Health District. “ We hope that by partnering with the Mall of Georgia we will make the vaccine easily available to those who are interested.”

Vaccine will be provided at no charge to the client. Persons are encouraged to bring their Medicaid, Medicare, or private insurance cards with them, for proper billing.

In addition, the Norcross Health Department located at 5030 Georgia Belle Court will also be providing the H1N1 vaccine and nasal spray on Saturday from 9:00am to 12:00pm.
